Chapped lips, and what to do for them!

Winter has arrived, and with the cold wind and dry air comes chapped skin and lips. Cracks can appear in the skin around the fingernails, causing some discomfort and occasional bleeding. Here are a couple of suggestions about how to avoid and relieve chapped skin and lips:

- If the air in your house seems dry from electric heat, try a room humidifier at night. This will help put some moisture into the air.
- Cover deep cracks in the skin with a thick ointment, such as Vaseline. Applying this overnight, under socks or gloves, will expedite the healing.
- If your child's lips are very dry and cracked, apply a thick layer of Vaseline. Then, scrub gently with a soft bristle toothbrush to exfoliate the dry skin. Leave a layer of the Vaseline on to heal and hydrate. Apply it frequently throughout the day.
- Lastly, chapped lips can be a sign that you are not getting enough water. You may find that increasing your fluid intake will improve your skin overall.
