## Students Aboard the Battleship

Salem Academy students explored the world's largest collection of historical naval ships on their recent trip to Battleship Cove, in Fall River, Massachusetts.

After touring the battleship *Massachusetts*, destroyer *Joseph P. Kennedy Jr.*, submarine *Lionfish*, PT Boats 617 & 796, and the Russian missile corvette *Hiddensee*, the students and teachers spent the night of Saturday, May 7<sup>th</sup>, 2011 on

board the destroyer *Joseph P. Kennedy Jr.*

Battleship Cove's Nautical Nights program includes teaching students knot tying, storytelling, a living history presenter, major motion pictures, and Morse Code classes. The trip gives everyone a better understanding and appreciation for the sacrifices made by veterans of all military branches in all wars.
